However, specific kayak models are designed for optimal use in specific environments. Like most inflatable kayaks the Big Basin sacrifices a bit of performance to gain a lot in portability and price tag. They are narrow and long, usually a minimum of 12 feet in length.

Flat planing hulls are common on whitewater boats, while more rounded bottoms. Two piece paddles can be broken down making them smaller and more easily transported, and their feather angle can be adjusted on the fly; most paddles coming with two or three possible positions.
